Official contest rules

ELIGIBILITY

2. 7. The draw for the Las Vegas trip will be held at 10 a.m., EST, Wednesday, January 18th, 2012 at the Clair de Lune office, in Ville St Laurent, Quebec, from all the contest entries and customers already subscribed. If an entry form drawn does not conform to all the conditions described in these Contest Rules, that participant's entry form will be declared invalid and a new draw will be held according to these Contest Rules until one valid entry form is declared the winner.

8. The chance of winning depends on the total number of eligible entries received by the contest closing date.

9. In the eventuality, that it is impossible to contact one of the selected entries after five (5) working days following the contest draw, or the selected entry fails to answer the skill testing question correctly, or the selected entry refuses the prize, or if the selected entry omits to return the claim form, another participant will be selected.

CLAIMING YOUR PRIZE

10. In order to be declared a winner, the drawn participant must:

a) have provided the correct answer to the skill-testing math question as requested by the Contest Organizer;

b) be contacted by the Contest Organizer within 2 days of the draw;
